

蘿蔔蹲 LUO-BO-DUN

😊 SUMMARY :

This game helps children to react quickly. It is also the chance for the children to speak Chinese.

😊 BACKGROUND :

It is very suitable for children to learn to react in a short time. When the children hear their name in this game, they should say the words fast in case of losing.

😊 AGE :

6-12 years old

😊 NUMBER OF CHILDREN :

3 or more

😊 VOCABULARY :

Luo-bo(蘿蔔) : A radish / Dun(蹲) : Squat / Lu(綠) : Green
Hong(紅) : Red / Bai(白) : White / Wan(完) : Finish

😊 RULES:

Take 3 children in this game as an example.

First, every child in this game needs to name themselves with a kind of radish. Each child will be green radish, red radish and white radish, respectively.

First child (green radish for example) will say his radish name while squatting, and then point out who will be the next player s/he to continue:

"Lu Luo Bo Dun, Lu Luo Bo Dun, Lu Luo Bo Dun Wan, Hong Luo Bo Dun"

(the green radish squats, the green radish squats, the green radish squats and then the red radish squats) with his squatting action at the same time.

The player named red radish needs to respond right away with,

"Hong Luo Bo Dun, Hong Luo Bo Dun, Hong Luo Bo Dun Wan, Bai Luo Bo Dun."

(the red radish squats, the red radish squats, the red radish squats and the (next player, for example) the white radish squats.

Children can choose anyone to be the next player. The order of this game will be decided by the children themselves.

The one who doesn't continue or say the wrong "color" of the radish will lose. There will be more fun with more people playing.
